Washing Advice for Handknits

Proper care of handknits is important for garments to maintain their shape and surface appearance. Read and understand the care symbols on the yarn labels. See the link above

All yarns, even easy care yarns such as Perfection and Tatamy, will benefit from being washed in a lingere bag. Use a gentle soap such as one of the popular wool washes.

Do not machine wash your easy care handknits in a load with towels, jeans or other heavy items.

If fibers are machine dryable, a short cycle at a low temperature is best, and then lay flat to finish drying.
