Cool Weather Cowl

**A perfect accent to any fall outfit.
Wear draped over a sweater, doubled
up as a scarf, or over head as a hood.**



Special Abbreviation:

SC tbl — single crochet through the back loop

Begin: Chain 45 sts.

Row 1: SC in the 3rd ch from hook, SC in each ch st across row.

Ch 1 and turn. (43 sts)

Row 2: SC tbl across row, ch 1 and turn.

Repeat Row 2 until piece measures 55", or desired length.

Do not ch 1 and fasten off.

Finishing:

Fold in half to join short ends and sew together forming a ring. To give the cowl a little flair, you can turn one side over for a twisted cowl effect.

Weave in ends and block if needed.

COMMONLY USED CROCHET ABBREVIATIONS

Beg	beginning	SC	single crochet	Sp	space(s)
Ch	chain(s)	DC	double crochet	Ch sp	chain space
Sk	skip	Lp	loop	Sl st	slip stitch

General Pattern Notes:

Round brackets — (ch 1, DC) repeat the combination enclosed in the round brackets. If repeated, 2x for example, number indicates times repeated..
