Mountain Springs Infinity Cowl

Inspired by one of our customers, this scarf has been immensely popular.

Wear it long or wrap it a few times – no matter what you do, you're sure to be stylish!

Notes:

K1 in st below: Instead of knitting the next stitch as usual, insert your needle into the stitch below it and knit into it – sliding the stitch below and the stitch above off the LH needle.

Joining the Ends: When you join the ends together you may put a twist into the cowl. Alternately, you could CO and BO as usual to make a traditional scarf.

Yarn choice: For our cowl we used a strand of Sterling Silk & Silver and Fountain Hill held together. This allows you to customize the look and make a garment that is truly unique. Pick two colors of the same shade or pick colors that contrast – the choice is up to you!

Cowl:

The two yarns are held together throughout.

CO 40 sts using a provisional cast on.

Set Up Row: *K1, P1 rep from * to end.

Pattern Row: K1, P1, *K1 in st below, P1 rep from * across.

Repeat pattern row until cowl reaches 80" or desired length.

Remove provisional CO and place sts on a second needle. Join ends using the 3-needle BO method.
