Felted Stacking Bowls

These coordinating bowls are a great addition to your creative space. Useful for displaying yarn, holding notions, or even as a coin collector, they'll bring a splash of color to any décor. When not in use, the bowls neatly nest inside one another for easy storage.



Large Bowl:

With Pine Nut and crochet hook, use Emily Ocher cast on to cast on 8 stitches. Transfer two stitches to each of four double pointed needles. Place a marker to identify beginning of round.

Round 1: Knit in front and in back of every stitch. (16 stitches)

Round 2 and all even rows: Knit.

Round 3: K1, Kf/b, repeat around (24 stitches)

Round 5: K2, Kf/b, repeat around (32 stitches)

Round 7: K3, Kf/b, repeat around (40 stitches)

Round 9: K4, Kf/b, repeat around (48 stitches)

Round 11: K5, Kf/b, repeat around (56 stitches)

Round 13: K6, Kf/b, repeat around (64 stitches)

Round 15: K7, Kf/b, repeat around (72 stitches)

Knit every round until piece is about six inches from last increase.

Cut Pine Nut. Using knit on cast on, cast on four stitches on left needle.

Next row: *Knit 3 stitches, K2tog through back loop. Return four stitches to left needle. Repeat from * until four stitches remain. Kitchner remaining four stitches to beginning of I cord or return stitches to left needle and bind off all stitches. Sew bound off stitches to beginning of I cord. Work in all ends.

Medium Bowl:

With Blueberry Pie work same as Bowl 1 until 48 stitches on needle. Knit five rows even. Work Round 11 from Bowl 1 increasing to 56 stitches. Knit seven more rows.

Next row: K5, K2tog, repeat around row.

Knit two rows.

Bind off all stitches.

Small Bowl:

With color Blueberry work same as bowl 1 until 36 stitches are on needle. Work 5 rows even. Bind off.

Place all bowls in pillowcase or mesh bag. Wash in washing machine on hot cycle with smallest amount of water until bowls are felted very firmly. Stuff bowls if necessary or place bowl or plate in felted bowl until dry.
