


EXPERIENCE Intermediate

YARN

Alpaca DK 1 MC 1 CC1 1 CC2 Sample was done in White, RoseGrey & Brown



Bias Stripe Cowl

Clara Masessa



This cowl is knitted flat. Increasing a stitch at the beginning & working 2 sts together at the end of right side rows causes the diagnal stripes. Folded in 1/2 for a cowl or opened to provide a hood.

Bias Stripe Cowl (Page 2)

Stockinette Stripe

1—K 1, M1, K to last two sts, K2tog

2—Purl 1 across

3-6—repeat rows 1 & 2

Reverse Stockinette row

1—K1, M1, K to last two sts, K2tog

2—K across

3—P1, M1, P to last 2 sts, P2tog

4 & 5— Repeat rows 2 & 3

6—repeat row 2

With MC and using a provision Cast ON CO 70 sts

Set up stripe — With MC work rows 1-4 only of Stockinette Stripe

Stripe 1— With CC1 work 6 rows Reverse Stockinette Stripe

Stripe 2 & 4 — With MC work the 6 rows of Stockinette Stripe

Stripe 3— With CC2 work 6 rows Reverse Stockinette Stripe

Repeat Stripes 1-4 until there are 22 reverse stockinette ridges ending with Stripe 3

Last Stripe—With MC work rows 5 & 6 of Stockinette Stripe.

Remove provisional CO and place sts on a needle. Using MC Kitchner stitch cast on edge to the last row. Work in all ends.

Kitchner Stitch:

Holding both needles parallel and making sure the working yarn is coming from the back needle, insert yarn into a large-eyed tapestry needle.

Set Up—Bring needle through 1st stitch on front needle as if to purl – leave stitch on needle. Go through 1st stitch on back needle as if to knit—leave stitch on needle.

Make sure to keep the yarn below the needles.

1—Go through 1st stitch on front needle as if to knit and slide off, then go though next stitch on front needle as if to purl—leave on needle

2—Go through 1st stitch on back needle as if to purl and slide off, then go through next stitch on back needle as if to knit—leave on needle

Continue working 1 & 2 until there is only 1 sts left on each needle.

Final Graft: Go through st on front needle as if to knit and slide it off, then go through st on back needle as if to P and slide it off. Cut yarn and pull tail through last
