Spring Fling

Felted Handbag

Fun! Fun! Fun! Fun to make ... fun to felt ... fun to use! An easy tube becomes a wonderful bag with a few simple steps. Looks great with the elegant Eskimo Mittens.

Spring Fling Felted Handbag

With two strands of Naturally Nazareth held together, cast on 32 sts.
Knit in Garter stitch for five ridges, 10 rows.

PM. Now pick up five sts along short side, PM, pick up 32 sts along long side, PM, pick up five sts along other short side, PM.

I've experimented with this and even though this can be a real pain, hang in there. By doing this there will be no sewing later.

Now, knit to each marker slipping as you come to it and knit until the tube measures 10 inches. Finish with a 32 st side. Place five stitches on a holder, then BO 37 stitches.

Flap:

Now begin reverse stockinette stitch for the same width as the bottom.

Begin pattern stitch:

Row 1: Knit

Row 2: K3, P26, K3

At this time you will be knitting two rows with one wool yarn and one novelty yarn held together, then two rows of two wool yarns held together, as follows:

C1: Moira - 2 Rows

C2: Naturally Nazareth - 2 Rows

C3: Fizz - 2 Rows

C4: Naturally Nazareth - 2 Rows

Repeat these 8 rows for eight inches, ending with a C4 set.

Edge:

Switch to Moira and knit garter stitch for four ridges (8 rows), decreasing one stitch each side on every right side row.

Bind off.

Strap:

With two Naturally Nazareth and one Moira held together, throughout, move those five sts from a stitch holder to a Double-Point Needle. Knit st st for two inches. After a knit row, begin I-cord for desired length then start two inches of st st. Sew these five sts to the first five sts on the other side of flap.

Tah Dah! Now, felt it. After felting, cut off any long, goofy yarns and enjoy!

I know you have some Fizz and Moira left. The Fizz would be good for the Elegant Eskimo Mittens. I am working on a hat for the leftover Moira, so please stay tuned for more patterns.
