Go To Market Bag

Go green by taking this crochet bag to market.

Use Tatamy or Tatamy Tweed DK in any color combination you like.

Bottom of bag: With color A, ch 47 sts and turn (46 sts).
Work rows of SC until bottom measures 6” wide.

Set-up row: Work around all 4 sides of the bottom of bag as follows.

Short side of base: Sl st into first row, ch 4, DC into same st. * Sk the next 2 rows and (DC, ch 1, DC) into next row; rep from * across short side of base.

Long side of base: (DC, ch 1, DC) into same st. * Sk the next 2 sts and (DC, ch 1, DC) into next st; rep from * across long side of base.

Rep for other short side and long side of bottom. Sl to join into rnd. Work body of bag in rnds without turning.

First Band: Cont with color A.

Rnd 1: Ch 4 sts, * DC, ch 1, DC into ch space; rep from * for rnd. Sl st to join rnd.

When sides of bag are 5” tall (or when you run out of color A) complete rnd and sl st to join rnd.

Second Band: Cut color A and join color B.

Rnd 1: Ch 3 * DC in next sp, DC in next 2 sts; rep from * to complete rnd. Sl st to join rnd.

Rnd 2: Ch 3, DC in each st, sl st to join rnd.

Rnd 3: Rep rnd 2.

Third Band: Cut color B and join color C.

Rnd 1: Ch 4, * sk 1st st, DC in next st, ch 1; rep from * for rnd. Sl into 2nd st of ch to join rnd.

Rnd 2 : Ch 3, * DC into ch sp, ch 1; rep from * for rnd. Sl into 2nd st of ch to join rnd.

When sides are 11” complete rnd and sl st to join rnd.

Top Band: Cut color C and join color B.

Rnd 1: Ch 2, * DC into ch sp, SC into next st; rep from * for rnd. Sl st to join rnd.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc for rnd, sl st to join rnd.

Rep Rnd 2 until Top Band is 3” and cut yarn.

Handles (make 2): With color C, ch 140 sts. Leave an 18” tail at beg of ch for sewing.

Rows 1-6: SC, ch 1 and turn.

Cut yarn leaving an 18” tail for sewing. Handles will be 1” wide.

Finishing: Fold Top Band in half towards the inside and with darning needle sew last rnd of the Top Band to the first row of Top Band. Find and mark the center of each long side with safety pins for handle placement. Place the ends of each handle on the outside of the bag and 5” apart, as in the photo. The ends of handles are at first row of Top Band. Securely sew ends of the handles through both layers of the Top Band.

COMMONLY USED CROCHET ABBREVIATIONS

Beg	beginning	SC	single crochet	Sp	space(s)
Ch	chain(s)	DC	double crochet	Ch sp	chain space
Sk	skip	Lp	loop	Sl st	slip stitch

General Pattern Notes:

Round brackets — (ch 1, DC) repeat the combination enclosed in the round brackets. If repeated, 2x for example, number indicates times repeated..
