Crochet for Baby * Bootie Trio

designed by Kristen Stoltzfus



Crochet Bootie is written for 3 month size in Perfection DK yarn. The larger sizes, 6 months or 9 months size, is made in Perfection WW yarn with a larger sized crochet hook.

There are 3 choices for different cuffs.



Crochet for Baby * Bootie Trio

Designer's Notes: Same foot instructions are used for all booties with 2 larger sizes, which are in (), made with thicker yarn and larger size crochet hooks. Cuff options include a Shell, Moccasin and Popcorn cuffs. Finished foot length of the booties are small 3½", medium 4¼", large 4½".

Special Abbreviations:

Popcorn (pc): Work 4 hdc in same st, drop lp from hook, insert hook in first hdc, yo, draw tight and ch 1 (ch 1 does not count as a separate st).

Shell: (hdc, dc, ch 1, dc, hdc) in same st.

Single crochet 2 together (sc2tog): Work sc in next 2 sts, retaining last lp of each sc on hook, yo, draw through all 3 lps on hook

Single crochet 3 together (sc3tog): Work sc in next 3 sts, retaining last lp of each sc on hook, yo, draw through all 4 lps on hook

Booties (make 2): With MC color and hook F (G, H). Ch 42 and join with sl st to form ring, being careful not to twist.

Foot:

Rnd 1 (RS): Ch 1, sc in same ch, work sc2tog, (sc in next ch, sc2tog) around; join with sl st to first sc (28 sc).

Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc in same st, work sc3tog, sc in each of next 11 sts, work sc3tog, sc in each of next 10 sts; join with sl st to first sc (24 sc).

Rnd 3: (sk next st, sl st in next st, hdc in each of next 9 sc), sl st in next st, rep between (); join with sl st in first sl st. Fasten off yarn, leaving long tail for sewing (18 hdc).
Working in back lps only, with darning needle whip-stitch Rnd 3 together on WS.

Sides:

Rnd 1: With RS facing, join yarn on one tip on opposite side of foundation ch, ch 1, sc in same st, sc in each of next 12 sts, hdc in next st, dc in next 15 sts, hdc in next st, sc in each rem st around; join with sl st in first sc (2 hdc, 15 dc, 25 sc).

Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc in same st, sc in each sc to last sc, sk last sc, hdc in hdc, dc in each dc, hdc in hdc, sk next sc, sc in each rem st around; join with sl st in first sc. (2 hdc, 15 dc, 23 sc).

Rnd 3: Rep Rnd 2.

Rnd 4: Ch 1, sc in same st, sc in each sc to last sc, sk last sc, ch 4, work a dc in each hdc and dc, retaining last lp of each dc on hook, yo, draw through all 18 lps on hook, ch 1 to secure, ch 4, sk next sc, sc in each rem st around; join with sl st in first sc, fasten off yarn (19 sc, 2 ch 4 lps).

Work booties to this point and choose one of 3 cuff options to complete.

Shell Cuff Option: do not fasten off MC yarn.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, turn, sc in same st, sk next sc, (shell in next sc, sk next sc, sc in next sc, sk next sc) twice, shell in ch 4 lp, sc in center hole, shell in ch 4 lp, sk next sc, sc in next sc, sk next sc, rep between ()s twice, omitting last sc, join with sl st in first sc (6 shells, 6 sc).

Crochet for Baby * Bootie Trio

Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc in same st, shell in shell, (sc in sc, shell in shell) around; join with sl st in first sc.

Rnds 3-7: Rep Rnd 2. At end of last rnd, fasten off.
Weave in all ends. Sew buttons to the top of the side on the outside, making right and left bootie. Use ch 1 sp in any shell for buttonhole. See cover page for details.



Moccasin Cuff Option:

Cuff: Join CC #1 in first sc after 2nd ch 4 lp, ch 1, sc in same st, hdc in each of next 2 sc, dc in each of next 13 sc, hdc in each of next 2 sc, sc in last sc; fasten off yarn.

Tie: With CC #1, ch 30, fasten off yarn. Use to tie ch 4 lps tog at base of Back Edge, knotting it to the ends if desired.

Weave in all ends. With CC #1, embroider top of toe. See photo above for details.

Popcorn Cuff Option:

Rnd 1: Join CC #1 in first sc after 2nd ch 4 lp, ch 1, sc in same st, (sk next sc, pc in next sc, sk next sc, sc in next sc) 4 times, sk next sc, pc in next sc, [(sc, work pc) in next ch 4 lp] twice; join with sl st in first sc, fasten off yarn (7 pc, 7 sc).

Rnd 2: Join CC #2 in center back pc of last rnd, ch 1, sc in same st, work pc in each sc and sc in each pc around; join with sl st in first sc, fasten off yarn.

Rnd 3: Join CC #1 in center back pc of last rnd, ch 1, sc in same st, ch 1, work pc in sc, ch 1, (sc in pc, ch 1, pc in sc, ch 1) around; join with sl st in first sc, fasten off yarn.

Rnd 4: With MC rep Rnd 3.

Rnd 5: With CC #1 rep Rnd 3.

Weave in all ends. See photo to the right.



COMMONLY USED CROCHET ABBREVIATIONS

Beg	beginning	SC	single crochet	Sp	space(s)
Ch	chain(s)	HDC	half double crochet	Lp	loop
Sk	skip	DC	double crochet	tog	together
yo	yarn over hook	TC	treble crochet	Sl st	slip stitch

General Pattern Notes:

Round brackets — (ch 1, DC) repeat the combination enclosed in the round brackets. If repeated, 2x for example, number indicates times repeated..
