Sophia's Bonnet

So many women begin (or return to) knitting when there's a baby on the way. This bonnet, with its basic knit and purl patterning, is perfect for such a knitter. It's not complex and it reinforces the basic stitches. It is knit flat with an optional crochet edging. It's quick to knit and so cute!

Bonnet:

CO 80 sts.

Beginning Rib:

Row 1: (k1, p1) across

Repeat Row 1 eight more times (9 times total)

Broken Rib:

Row 1 (WS): Knit

Row 2: (k1, p1) across

Repeat Row 1 and 2 until bonnet measure 4" from beginning.

Garter Stitch Decreases:

Rows 1-5: Knit

Row 6 (RS): (k6, k2tog) across (70 sts)

Row 7: Knit

Row 8: (k5, k2tog) across (60 sts)

Row 9: Knit

Row 10: (k4, k2tog) across (50 sts)

Row 11: Knit

Row 12: (k3, k2tog) across (40 sts)

Row 13: Knit

Row 14: (k2, k2tog) across (30 sts)

Row 15: Knit

Row 16: (k1, k2tog) across (20 sts)

Row 17: (knit

Row 18: k2tog across (10 sts)

Cut yarn leaving an 8" tail. Draw yarn through remaining 10 sts. Fasten off.

Crochet Edging:

(This edging is optional. It is not shown on sample.)

Rnd 1: Starting at back wearer's right corner, sc along all edges.

Rnd 2: sc along wearer's right edge. Along front edge work shell pattern as follows: *skip 1 sc, sc in next sc, ch 3, in same sc work 2 dc, rep from *. SC along wearer's left edge and back. Fasten off.

Ties: (make 2)

Chain 54 or number needed to reach 11". Sew to corners at front of bonnet.
