2 1/2-3 sts =4"

**Knitting must be loose
to felt properly**

US 11 (8 mm)

16 or 24"" Circular

And double points in
size #11 or 10.5

Felted Hat

Felted Hat

This hat is easy to knit and works up fast. It can be worn 3 different ways

1. brim down
2. rolled up
3. down in front /rolled up in back.



Felted Hat

Loosly cast on 90 stitches.

Place marker and join in the round, being careful not to twist sts

Rnd 1—K

Rnd 2—K

Rnd 3—*K9, M1, repeat from * around (100 sts)

Continue knitting in the round until work measures 3"

Next Rnd— *K8, K2 tog, repeat from * around (90 sts)

Continue knitting in the round until work from beginning measures 5"

Beginning of Crown: (change color at this point if desired)

Mark this point as the beginning of crown.

Rnd 1—*(K2tog) 4 times, K1, repeat from * around (50 sts)

Rnd 2 & 3—K around

Rnd 4—*K2, M1, K3, M1, repeat from * around (70 sts)

Continue knitting in the round on these 70 sts until the length from the beginning of the crown is 9" **NOTE: if you changed colors at the beginning of the crown, change back to the main color when total length from the beginning of the crown is 3." Then continue knitting in the round with the MC until total length of crown is 9"**

Shape top

(change to double pointed needles when work no long fits onto circular needles)

Rnd 1— *K5, K2tog, repeat from * around (60 sts)

Round 2 and all even rounds: Knit

Rnd 3—*k4, K2tog, repeat from * around (50 sts)

Rnd 5—*K3, K2tog, repeat from * around (40 sts)

Rnd 7—*K2, K2tog, repeat from * around (30 sts)

Rnd 9—*K1, K2tog, repeat from * around (20 sts)

Rnd 11—*K2tog, repeat from * around (10 sts)

Rnd 12—*K2tog, repeat from * around. Cut yarn, pull it through remaining stitches, pull tightly and fasten off.

Weave in all ends before felting.

Felting:

To protect your washer from excessive lint, place hat in a pillow case, tie shut. Set the washer to hot wash, cold rinse, lowest water level. Check on the hat every 5 minutes., turning the setting back to agitate until work is felted. Felting should take approx. 25 minutes. When desired felting is achieved, rinse and spin LIGHTLY so as not to cause creases. Remove hat, stretch over a bowl slightly larger than your head. Curl up the brim if desired. Remove excess lint and let dry which may take up to 2 days.
