Two classic names for two classic hats. These hats are fun to make and a great accessory for any wardrobe. A beautiful way to beat the cold wind and still look cool.

BETTY HAT

Top: Starting at top of hat, chain 2.

Rnd 1: Work eight hdc in second ch from hook = eight sts.
DO NOT JOIN AND DO NOT TURN. Work in rnds throughout.

Rnd 2: Work two hdc in each st around = 16 sts.

Rnd 3: Work two hdc in each st around = 32 sts.

Following Rnds:

Continuing in rnds, * work one hdc in each of next four sts, work two hdc in next st. Repeat from * around until piece measures approximately six and three quarter inches in diameter (or across), and ending with a multiple of four sts. Place safety pin marker in last st.

Crown: Work even in hdc without increasing until piece measures approx three and a half inches from safety pin marker.

Beading Rnd: Work one dc in each st around.

Brim:

Rnd 1: * Sc in next st, sk one st, six dc in next st, sk one st. Repeat from * around.
Join with sl st to beg sc.

Rnd 2: Ch three, work six dc in same sp, working behind Rnd 1, * sc between the two middle dc's and around the st of Beading Rnd, 7 dc in next sc. Repeat from * around, ending with sc in last sc, sl st to top of beg ch-3.

Fasten off.

Tie: With 2 strands of yarn, chain approx 26"

Fasten off.

Thread tie through Beading Rnd, try on hat and adjust tie to fit head. Tie a knot and trim tie ends.

BONNIE HAT

With MC, work as for Betty until Crown measures approximately two and a half inches from safety pin marker, ending with an odd number of sts.

Hat Band:

Rnd 1: Drop MC and attach CC and work (sc in next st, dc in next st) around.

Rnds 2 and 3: Work dc in each sc, sc in each dc around. Drop CC.

Beading Rnd: Pick up MC and work one dc in each st around.

Brim:

Rnd 1: * Work hdc in each of next eight sts, two hdc in next st. Repeat from * around.

Rnds 2 and 3: Work one hdc in each st around. Fasten off MC.

Under Brim:

Rnd 1: With CC, work one hdc in back loop only of each st around.

Rnds 2 and 3: Work one hdc in each st around. Fasten off, leaving approximately one yard for sewing.

Tie: With two strands of yarn, chain approximately 26". Fasten off.

Finishing: Turn under brim inside, and sew to Beading Rnd. Thread Tie through Beading Rnd, try on hat and adjust tie to fit head. Tie a knot and trim tie ends.

beg	beginning	pat(s)	pattern(s)	st(s)	stitch(es)
ch	chain	rnd(s)	round(s)	tog	together
dc	double crochet	sc	single crochet	tr	triple or treble crochet
hdc	half double crochet	sk	skip	yo	yarn over hook
lp	loop(s)	sp(s)	space(s)		

NOTES

1. A star * shown in a pattern row denotes that the stitches shown after this sign must be repeated from that point.
2. Round brackets () enclosing a particular stitch combination denotes that the stitch combination must be repeated in the order shown.
3. Square brackets [] enclosing a particular stitch combination denotes that the stitch combination must be repeated within a stitch combination in the order shown.
4. A slip stitch is a non stitch and does not count as a stitch.
