


# Café Stole

### YARN

Kraemer Yarns Alpaca Handknitting Yarn DK

(70% Alpaca / 30% Merino Wool)



6 Skeins (Sample shown in color Rose Gray)

#### GAUGE

Gauge: | sts = 1"

Knitting Needles:
US 6 / 4 mm
24" circular or size
needed to obtain gauge

Notions:
Two Stitch Markers

Finished Measurements 20" X 90"



This project uses the "coffee bean pattern" found in an old knitting book from 1934 and adapted to a warm and soft stole made with our cozy Alpaca & Merino wool blend yarn.



#### Seed Stitch Pattern:

**Row 1:** [K1, P1] repeat between [] to end. **Row 2:** Purl the knit stitches and knit the purl stitches to the end.

## Coffee Bean Pattern with seed stitch border:

**Row 1:** Work in seed stitch for 16 stitches, place marker, [yo, k3, yo, k3tog]; repeat between [] to last 16 stitches, place marker, work in seed stitch to end of row.

**Row 2:** Work in seed stitch to marker, purl to marker, work in seed stitch to end of row.

**Row 3:** Work in seed stitch to marker, [k2tog, k1, k2tog, yo, k1, yo]; repeat between [] to marker, work in seed stitch to end of row.

**Row 4:** Work in seed stitch to marker, purl to marker, work in seed stitch to end of row.

**Row 5:** Work in seed stitch to marker, [yo, k3tog, yo, k3]; repeat between [] to marker, work in seed stitch to end of row.

**Row 6:** Work in seed stitch to marker, purl to marker, work in seed stitch to end of row.

**Row 7**: Work in seed stitch to marker, [yo, k1, yo, k2tog, k1, k2tog]; repeat between [] to marker, work in seed stitch to end of row.

**Row 8:** Work in seed stitch to marker, purl to marker, work in seed stitch to end of row.

#### Stole Pattern:

Cast on 80 sts w/ US #6 knitting needles.

Work in seed stitch pattern 12 times (24 rows).

Work the eight row coffee bean pattern with seed stitch border 26 times (208 rows).

Work in seed stitch pattern 12 times (24 rows).

Work the eight row coffee bean pattern with seed stitch border 10 times (80 rows).

Work in seed stitch pattern 12 times (24 rows).

Work the eight row coffee bean pattern with seed stitch border 26 times (208 rows).

Work in seed stitch pattern 12 times (24 rows).

Bind off in pattern.

Hand wash and block before wearing.
