# Fall Shawl

Be ready for the fall chill in your fetching Fall Shawl. An easy crochet project that features a shaped neck which sits perfectly on your shoulders.



**Special stitches:**

**Fhdc** (foundation half double crochet) – Chain 3, yarn over, insert hook in 3<sup>rd</sup> chain from hook, yarn over and pull up loop (3 loops on hook), yarn over and draw through 1 loop (1 chain made), yarn over and draw through all loops on hook—1 fhdc made. \*Yarn over, insert hook under the 2 loops of the “chain” stitch of last stitch and pull up loop, yarn over and draw through 1 loop, yarn over and draw through all loops on hook; repeat from \* for length of foundation.

**V-st** – dc, ch 1, dc in stitch indicated.

**Directions:**

**Set up row: Fhdc 8 or Ch 10, hdc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook and each chain afterward, turn. ( 8 hdc)**

**Row 1:** Ch 3, V-st in each of the next 8 hdc, dc in top of turning ch., turn.

**Row 2:** Ch 3, V-st in V-st, \*dc in between V-st, V-st in next V-st, repeat from \* 6 times, dc in top of turning ch, turn.

**Row 3:** Ch 3, V-st in V-st, \*dc in between each st to next V-st, V-st in next V-st, repeat from \* 6 times, dc in top of turning ch, turn.

**Row 4 – 30:** Repeat Row 3. After Row 30 you should have 29 dc between each set of V-sts.

**Edging:**

**Row 1:** Ch 1, sc in each st across bottom edge, 2 sc in each edge dc or ch 3, sc in the edge of hdc row, sc in each fdc, sc in the edge of hdc row, 2 sc in each edge dc or ch 3, join with sl st to 1<sup>st</sup> sc. **(229 sc across bottom, 61 sc across each side and 8 sc across the top for a total of 359 sc)**

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in 1<sup>st</sup> sc, \* skip next sc, 5dc in next sc, skip 1 sc, sc in next sc, repeat from \* across bottom of shawl (57 – 5dc shells) going along the edge sc in next 2 sc, \*\* ch 2, skip 2 sc, sc in next 2 sc, repeat from \*\* up the side to the top ( should have 15 ch-2 spaces), sc in next 11 sc, ^ ch 2, skip 2 sc, sc in next 2 sc, repeat from ^ down the side to the bottom ( should have 15 ch-2 spaces), join with sl st to 1<sup>st</sup> sc, and fasten off.
