Chunky Fingerless Mitts

Your hands will feel very cozy in these easy and quick to knit mitts made with our super soft and warm Alpaca/Merino chunky yarn.

What a great gift idea for your family and friends.



Chunky Fingerless Mitts

Cuff:

CO 28 sts and divide over 3 needles as follows: 8 sts each on needles 1 and 2, 12 sts on needle 3.

Join to work in the round being careful not to the twist sts.

Work in k2, p2 ribbing for 4" or desired cuff length.

Thumb Gusset:

Rnd 1: K1, m1, pm, k1, p2 (K2, p2) to end.

Rnd 2: K to m, sm, k1, p2, (k2, p2) to end.

Rnd 3: K1, m1, k to marker, m1, sm, k1, p2 (k2, p2) to end.

Repeat rows 2 and 3, three more times.

There are 9 gusset sts (10 sts before marker)

Repeat row 2 once more.

Next Rnd: K1, place next 9 sts on a holder, remove marker, k1, p2, (k2, p2) to end.

Hand:

Rnd 1: K2 (this closes the gap of the gusset), p2, (k2, p2) to end.

Continue in k2, p2 ribbing for 1½" more. BO in k2, p2 ribbing.

Thumb:

Place the 9 gusset sts back onto dpn.

Rnd 1: (k2, p2) twice, k1, pick up and knit 3 sts along hand to fill in gap. PM for beg of rnd.

Rnd 2: (k2, p2) around.

Repeat Rnd. 2 once more. BO in k2, p2 ribbing.

Repeat for the second mitt.
