A frilly way to fight the freeze. This crocheted beauty is a great accent piece or a fun scarf when doubled. Made with Naturally Nazareth, one daisy at a time, connecting them as you go. Daisies are a wonderful way to brighten a winter day!

Crocheted Daisy Chain

Flower #1: With Ice Skate, ch 4, join with sl st to form a ring. (Sl st in ring, ch 10) 12 times = 12 ch - 10 lps. Fasten off.

Flower #2: With Winter, ch 4, join with sl st to form a ring. (Sl st in ring, ch 10) nine times. Ch 5, with wrong sides of #1 and #2 tog, sl st in any ch - 10 lp on #1, ch 5, sl st in ring on #2. (Ch 5, sl st in next ch-10 lp on #1, ch 5, sl st in ring on #2. (Ch 5, sl st in next ch-10 lp on #1, ch 5, sl st ring on #2) two times. Fasten off.

Flower #3: With Sleigh, ch 4, join with sl st to form a ring. (Sl st in ring, ch 10) nine times. Ch 5, with wrong sides of #2 and #3 tog, and skipping 3 ch-10 lps on #2, complete as for #2. Fasten off.

Repeat Flower #3 in the following color sequence: * Ice Skate, Winter, Sleigh. Winter. Repeat from *, until Daisy Chain measures approximately 9' or desired length. Work in all ends.

dc	double crochet	sc	single crochet	tr	triple or treble crochet
hdc	half double crochet	sk	skip	yo	yarn over hook
lp	loop(s)	sp(s)	space(s)		

NOTES

1. A star * shown in a pattern row denotes that the stitches shown after this sign must be repeated from that point.
2. Round brackets () enclosing a particular stitch combination denotes that the stitch combination must be repeated in the order shown.
3. Square brackets [] enclosing a particular stitch combination denotes that the stitch combination must be repeated within a stitch combination in the order shown.
4. A slip stitch is a non stitch and does not count as a stitch.
