Pattern:

R1 (RS): p1, yo, k4, sl1 k2tog pssso, k4, yo, p1
R2 (WS): k1, p11, k1
R3: p1, k1, yo, k3, sl1 k2tog pssso, k3, yo, k1, p1
R4: k1, p11, k1
R5: p1, k2, yo, k2, sl1 k2tog pssso, k2, yo, k2, p1
R6: k1, p11, k1
R7: p1, k3, yo, k1, sl1 k2tog pssso, k1, yo, k3, p1
R8: k1, p11, k1
R9: p1, k4, yo, sl1 k2tog pssso, yo, k4, p1
R10: k1, p11, k1
R11: p1, yo, k4, sl1 k2tog pssso, k4, yo, p1
R12: k1, p11, k1
R13: p1, k1, yo, k3, sl1 k2tog pssso, k3, yo, k1, p1
R14: k1, p11, k1
R15: p1, k2, yo, k2, sl1 k2tog pssso, k2, yo, k2, p1
R16: k1, p11, k1
R17: p1, k3, yo, k1, sl1 k2tog pssso, k1, yo, k3, p1
R18: k1, p11, k1
R19: p1, k4, yo, sl1 k2tog pssso, yo, k4, p1
R20: k1, p11, k1

Notes:

- Repeat 12-stitch pattern repeat (highlighted in blue box) until end of row.
- Repeat rows 1-10 of chart, 14 times.

Begin Pattern:

Sleeves (Make 2)

Cast on 86 sts.

Work broken ribbing sleeve edge:

Row 1: *p2, k2* repeat between asterisks to last 2 sts, p2.

Row 2: Purl all sts.

Work rows 1 & 2 10 times for a total of 20 rows worked. Then work row 1 once more.

Lace set-up row: p42, p2tog, p42. (85sts.)

Begin cathedral lace (*Refer to chart on previous page*):

Work the 10 rows (*rows highlighted in blue box*) of the chart 14 times.

Do not bind off. Leave sts on a spare needle.
Knit 2nd sleeve.

Finishing

Graft pieces together using Kitchener Stitch.

Sew sleeves up from the broken ribbing to a comfortable-feeling opening under your arms.

Triceratops edge:

Pick up and knit 5 sts. along the inside body of the shrug, turn; purl 5, turn; knit 5, turn; purl 5, turn.

Bind off 4 sts; pick up and knit 1 st, bind off 1 st.

***Pick up and knit 4 sts, turn; purl 5, turn; knit 5, turn; purl 5, turn.**

Bind off 4 sts; pick up and knit 1 st; bind off 1 st.*

Repeat between asterisks until completely around the entire inside body of the shrug.

Weave in all loose ends.
