Kitten Whiskers Baby Blanket

There are three size options for this snuggly blanket which is knit using the interesting Whisker Stitch pattern done using slip stitches, giving the pattern that unique look. Just right for baby, child or adult. Why not make yourself a throw for lounging with your favorite whiskered faced pet. Items made with our Tatamy Tweed yarn are easy to care for.

Just machine wash & dry.



Kitten Whiskers Baby Blanket

Designer notes:

- Markers are placed to indicate the garter stitch border.
- When slipping stitches carry yarn loosely across the back of work to avoid puckering.

Whisker Stitch instructions:

Slip right hand needle under 3 strands.
Knit next st. pulling yarn loop through the strands.

Start Pattern: CO 117, (177, 197) sts.

Border: K 8 rows.

Whiskers Pattern:

Row 1: (WS) K5, pm, p to last 5 sts, pm, k5.

Row(s) 2, 4, 6, & 8: (RS) K across.

Row 3: K5, p to last 5 sts, k5.

Row 5: (WS) K5, p1, *wyib, sl 5 sts, wyif, p5, rep from * to last 11 sts, wyib, sl 5, p1, k5.

Row 7: Rep. row 5.

Row 9: Rep. row 5

Row 10: (RS) K8, *Whisker St., k9, rep. from * to last 9 sts, Whisker st, k8.

Row 11: (WS) K5, p to last 5 sts, k5.

Row(s) 12, 14, 16, & 18: K across.

Row 13: K5, p to last 5 sts, k5.

Row 15: (WS) K5, P6, *wyib, sl 5 sts, wyif, p5, rep from * to last 6 sts, p1, k5.

Row 17: Rep row 15.

Row 19: Rep row 15

Row 20: (RS) K13, *Whisker st, k9, rep from * to last 14 sts, Whisker st, k13.

Repeat the 20 rows 7 (12, 19) more times, then rep rows 1 - 3 once more.

Border: K 8 rows
BO and weave in ends.
