## *Crochet Ripple Kitchen Towel*

An easy crocheted hand towel that can be completed over a weekend. Alternate increases and decreases create the interesting ripple effect of this towel, that will look great in any kitchen. Make one for every season and for holiday gifts.



**Special Abbreviations:** *(read prior to starting project)*

**Dc2tog:** yo, insert the hook in the next st, draw up a loop, yo draw through the 1st 2 loops on the hook, **skip the next st**, yo, insert the hook in the next st, draw up a loop, yo draw through 2 loops, yo and draw through the last 3 loops.

**V st** - dc, ch1, dc all in the same st

**Dc Dec** - \*yo, insert hook in next st, draw up a loop, yo, draw through 2 loops on hook. Repeat from \* for indicated sts. End row with, yo, pull through all loops on hook.

**Notes:**

- Ch 3 counts as a dc throughout.
- Crochet through back loops for every row but the last row.

**Begin:**

Ch 64

**Row 1:** Work 1 dc 4th ch from hook, \*1 dc in next 4 ch, Dc2tog, dc in next 4 ch, V st in next ch, repeat from \* 3x, dc in next 4 ch, Dc2tog, dc in next 4 ch, 2 dc in last ch, ch 4, turn

**Work in Back Loops Only Through Row 10.**

**Row 2:** dc in same st as the ch 4, \*dc in next 4 sts, Dc2tog, dc in next 4 sts, V st in next st, repeat from \* 3x, dc in next 4 sts, Dc2tog, dc in next 4 sts, 2 dc in top of turning ch, ch 4, turn

Repeat Row 2 - 21 more times ending 21st row with ch 3, turn, next:

**Row 1:** - dc in base of ch 3, work Dc2tog across, dc in last 2 st, ch 3, turn

**Row 2:** - dc into next st, work across including into ch 3, ch 3, turn (22 dc's)

**Row 3:** dc dec across row, ch 3, turn.

**Row 4:** dc across row, including into top of ch, ch 3, turn. (11 including ch.)

**Row 5:** dc across row, including into top of ch, ch 3, turn.

**Rows 6-9:** repeat row 5, ch 4, turn.

**Row 10:** count the turning ch as first tr. Tr across row. Ch 4, turn.

**Do not work in back loops**

**Last row:** [yo, pull up a loop in next st, yo, pull through 2 loops] repeat for next 4 stitches, yo pull through all loops. Repeat for remaining stitches.

Fasten off and weave in ends. Turn over flap and use middle of treble stitch row as buttonhole.

Sew button and admire your work.
