Chevron Adventure

Brighten up the dreary days of winter by going on a Chevron Adventure adding splashes of color to your décor. A pleasure to knit and look at. Worked in 4 colors using 3 types of decreases to create the chevron design.



Stitch Key:

SK2P: Slip one st purlwise, k two sts together, pass slipped st over the two sts knit together.

M1L(Make 1 left): Pick up the bar between the st just knit and the next st, bringing the needle from front to back. Then k into the back of the st.

M1R(Make 1 right): Pick up the bar between the st just knit and the next st, bringing the needle from back to front. Then k into the front of the st.

Designers Note:

⇒ MC (Main color) and CC1 (Contrast Color 1) are carried along right edge throughout afghan. CC2 are carried as four rows of CC3 are knit. It is suggested that carried colors be caught on third stitch to hide along right edge.

⇒ Pattern is a 15+2 stitch repeat.

Begin Afghan:

Using long tail cast-on and size U.S. 9 needle, loosely CO 212 sts.

Set-up row:

Knit 1, purl across, knit 1.

Begin Pattern:

Row 1: * (K2, M1L, K5, SK2P, K5, M1R), repeat from * thirteen more times to last 2 sts, K2.

Row 2: K1, purl across, K1.

Repeat pattern rows 1 and 2 in the following color sequence.

Rows 1 - 14: MC (Main Color)

Rows 15 - 20: CC1 (Contrast Color 1)

Rows 21 - 24: MC

Rows 25 - 26: CC2 (Contrast Color 2)

Rows 27 - 30: CC3 (Contrast Color 3)

Rows 31 - 32: CC2

Rows 33 - 36: MC

Rows 37 - 42: CC1

Rows 1 - 42 create the color sequence pattern.

Repeat rows 1 - 42, five more times.

Repeat rows 1 - 14, one time.

Bind off in pattern. Weave in ends.

Block lightly to emphasize the chevron points.

Alternate size 60" x 48"

Follow the pattern as instructed, with the following changes:

To make a larger afghan cast on 242 sts. After completing the set-up row, repeat the stitch pattern in row 1 fifteen more times to last 2 sts, K2.

Work Row 2.

Repeat row 1 and row 2 in color sequence below.

Color sequence: Repeat rows 1 - 42, 7 times.

Repeat rows 1 - 14 in main color, one time.
