GAUGE

25 1/2 sts & 34 1/2 rows
= 4 inches in st st on larger
needle without blocking.
23sts = 4" in seed stitch
on larger needle
1 lace repeat = 3.25" after
blocking.

& US 4 (3 1/2 mm) circular
needles to hold all the
stitches

Lace Embrace

A lovely lace cover with a dramatic touch of silver. This v-neck cardigan has 3/4 length sleeves and a tie front. The perfect item to cover up for a day at the office, a night at the movies or a walk on the beach.



Designer Notes:

1. Pattern written for smallest size with other sizes in parentheses, when only one number is listed it applies to all sizes.
2. First and last st is a st st selvage st. Knit on RS row and Purl on WS rows.
3. Perform all decreases two sts in from edge.
4. If there are not enough sts to work pattern, work sts in st st
5. Bind off loosely in pattern. Use larger needle if necessary.

Stitch Patterns:

Seed Stitch

Row 1: K1, *P1, K1, repeat from * to end

Row 2: Reverse the sequence in Row 1 by knitting the purl stitches and purling the knit stitches.

Lace Panel 20 sts.

Row 1: K1, P1, K3, YO, K2, SSK, K5, K2tog, K2, YO, P1, K1

Row 2: This and all WS rows: knit the knit st and purl everything else.


Row 3: K1, P1, K4, YO, K2, ssk, K3, K2tog, K2, YO, K1, P1, K1

Row 5: K1, P1, K5, YO, K2, ssk, K1, K2tog, K2, YO, K2, P1, K1

Row 7: K1, P1, YO, K2, ssk, K5, K2tog, K2, YO, K3, P1, K1

Row 9: K1, P1, K1, YO, K2, ssk, K3, K2tog, K2, YO, K4, P1, K1

Row 11: K1, P1, K2, YO, K2, ssk, K1, K2tog, K2, YO, K5, P1, K1



BACK

With smaller needle, using long tail method, CO 115 (125, 135) sts,

Work 4 rows of Seed Stitch. Next Row, increase 1 sts at beginning of the row. [116 (126, 136) sts] Switch to larger needles and establish pattern as follows,

Row 1 (RS): K2, P2, K3, P2, K1, PM, Seed Stitch over next 5, (10, 15) sts, PM, [Lace Panel over next 20 sts, P2] 3 times, Lace Panel over next 20 sts, PM, Seed Stitch over next 5 (10, 15) sts, PM, K1, P2, K3, P2, K2. Continue in established pattern, ribbing the first and last 10 sts as established, and following the Seed Stitch and Lace Panel directions for the rest of the stitches. Work until piece measures 15 (15 ½, 16)'' from CO edge. End with WS row.

Begin Armhole Shaping (RS row): BO 6 (7, 8) sts at the beginning of the next two rows. [104 (112, 120) sts]. Decrease 1 st at each armhole edge every RS row 6 (9, 12) times [92 (94, 96) sts]. Continue working in established pattern until piece measures 22 (23 ½, 25)''.



LACE EMBRACE CONT'D

Neck Shaping: Work in pattern across 25 (26, 27) sts, K8, attach new yarn and BO 26 sts, K8, work remaining 25 (26, 27) sts in pattern. Continuing in established pattern and working both sides at the same time, decrease 1 st every other row at neck edge 3 times, and at same time, at armhole edge, BO 10 st 3 (2, 1) times and 11 sts 0 (1, 2) times. BO left side shoulder on RS rows and right side shoulder on WS rows.

LEFT FRONT

With smaller needle, using long tail method, CO 57 (61, 65) sts,

Work 4 rows of Seed Stitch. Switch to larger needles, increase 1 st at beginning of the row. [58, 62, 66 sts] Establish pattern as follows,

Row 1 (RS): [K3, P2] 2 times, K1, PM. Seed stitch over next 19 (23, 27) sts, PM, Lace Panel over next 20 sts, PM, P2, K3, P2, K1. Continue in established pattern, ribbing the first 10 sts as established, and following the Seed Stitch and Lace Panel directions for the rest of the stitches. Work until piece measures 15 (15 ½, 16)'' from CO edge. End with WS row. BO 6 (7, 8) sts at the beginning of the next row. [52 (55, 58) sts]. Decrease 1 st at armhole edge every RS row 6 (9, 12) times [46 sts]. Continue working in established pattern until piece measures 15 (16 ½, 18) end with a WS row.

Neck Shaping: (RS) Work in pattern across 17 sts, K2tog, continue in established pattern across sts. Continue decreasing 1 in the first K1 st of the lace panel every RS row 16 (15, 14) times [30,31, 32 sts]. Work remaining sts in pattern, until piece measures 22 (23.5, 25)'' Next RS row at armhole edge, BO 10 st 3 (2, 1) times and 11 sts 0 (1, 2) times.

RIGHT FRONT

With smaller needle, using long tail method, CO 57 (61, 65) sts,

Work 4 rows of Seed Stitch. Switch to larger needles, increase 1 st at end of the row. [58, 62, 66 sts] Establish pattern as follows,

Row 1 (RS):K1, P2, K3, P2, PM, Lace Panel over next 20 sts, PM, Seed stitch over next 19 (23, 27) sts, PM, K1 [P2, K3] 2 times. Continue in established pattern, ribbing the last 10 sts as established, and following the Seed Stitch and Lace Panel directions for the rest of the stitches. Work until piece measures 15 (15 ½, 16)'' from CO edge. End with RS row. BO 6 (7, 8) sts at the beginning of the next row. [52 (55, 58) sts]. Decrease 1 st at armhole edge every RS row 6 (9, 12) times [46 sts]. Continue working in established pattern until piece measures 15 (16 ½, 18) end with a WS row.

Neck Shaping: (RS) Work in pattern across 27 sts, ssk, continue in established pattern across remaining sts. Continue decreasing 1 in the last K1 st of the lace panel every RS row 16 (15, 14) times [30,31, 32 sts]. Work remaining sts in pattern, until piece measures 22 (23 ½, 25)'' Next RS row at armhole edge, BO 10 st 3 (2, 1) times and 11 sts 0 (1, 2) times.

SLEEVE

With smaller needle, using long tail method CO 61 (63, 67) sts,

Work 4 rows of Seed Stitch. Switch to larger needles and establish pattern as follows

Row 1 (RS): K3, P2, K3, P2, K1, PM, Seed Stitch over next 10 (11,13) sts, PM, [Lace Panel over next 20 sts, PM, Seed Stitch over next 10 (11, 13) sts, PM, K1, P2, K3, P2, K2. Continue in established pattern, ribbing the first and last 11 sts as established, and following the Seed Stitch and Lace Panel directions for the middle. Work one WS row.


Now begin to increase 1 st each side of sleeve between the ribbing and seed stitches, working new st into seed stitch pattern. Every 4th RS 0 (0, 8) times, Every 6th row 0 (17, 12) times, every 8th row 12 (0, 0) times [85, 97, 107 sts]

Work straight until sleeve measures 13 (13 ¼, 13½)'' Next RS row. BO 6 (7, 8) sts at the beginning of the next two rows. [73, 83, 91 sts] Every RS row, decrease 1 st at each side 6 (8, 8) times [61, 67, 75 sts]. At the beginning of the next 4 rows, BO 10 sts. [21, 27, 35] Ending with a WS row, BO all sts in pattern, working lace in st st.

Sew Shoulders, attach sleeves and sew side and sleeve seems starting at edge working toward armhole.

TRIM

With RS Facing, Starting at lower right front and using smaller needles, Pick up and knit 281 (297, 315) sts as follows, 85 (93, 102) up right front, 40 on V-neck, 32 back neck sts, 40 on Vneck and 84 (92, 101) on Lower left front. Work 3 rows of seed stitch, BO all sts in pattern. With WS facing, at bottom of V-neck pick up 3 sts in trim ridge. Work 3 st I cord for 12.'' Repeat on other side. Weave in ends.
