# Bedford Springs Shawl with scallop edge

A subtle scalloped edge provides just enough interest for this seed stitch shoulder shawl. One skein of yarn is all you need to create this beauty. It will become a must-have accessory in your wardrobe.

**SEED STITCH** (odd number of sts)  
All rows: K1; \*P1, K1; rep from \* across row.

**SUGAR SCALLOPS** (cast on multiple of 11 + 2)

**Row 1** (wrong side): K.

**Row 2:** P.

**Row 3:** K2; \*K1 and slip this stitch back onto left-hand needle, lift the next 8 sts, one at a time, over this stitch and off needle, yo twice, K the first st again, K2; rep from \* across: 6 sts dec in each multiple; now a multiple of 5 + 2

**Row 4:** K1; \*P2tog, drop one loop of "YO twice" of previous row; (K1, P1, K1, P1, K1) in remaining loop, P1; repeat from \* to last stitch, K1: 2 sts inc in each multiple, now a multiple of 7 + 2

These four rows form the scallops.

To adapt size: Multiply 4 times the number of repeats to determine number of sts that will be "lost".

**NOTE:** Shawl is worked sideways beginning with the ruffle.

## DIRECTIONS

With US 9 circular needle, cast on 343 sts (31 reps of 11 + 2).

Work the 4 rows of Sugar Scallops pattern

After working Row 3 you will have: 157 sts (multiple of 5 + 2, 31 reps, 6 sts dec in each repeat).

After Row 4 you will have: 219 sts (multiple of 7 + 2, 31 reps 2 sts inc in each repeat).

Scallop measures approx. 1" in length. Work in seed stitch for approx. 11" or as desired until approx. 5 yards of yarn remain.

Bind off all sts loosely in pattern.

Weave in all ends.

Block lightly to measurements.
